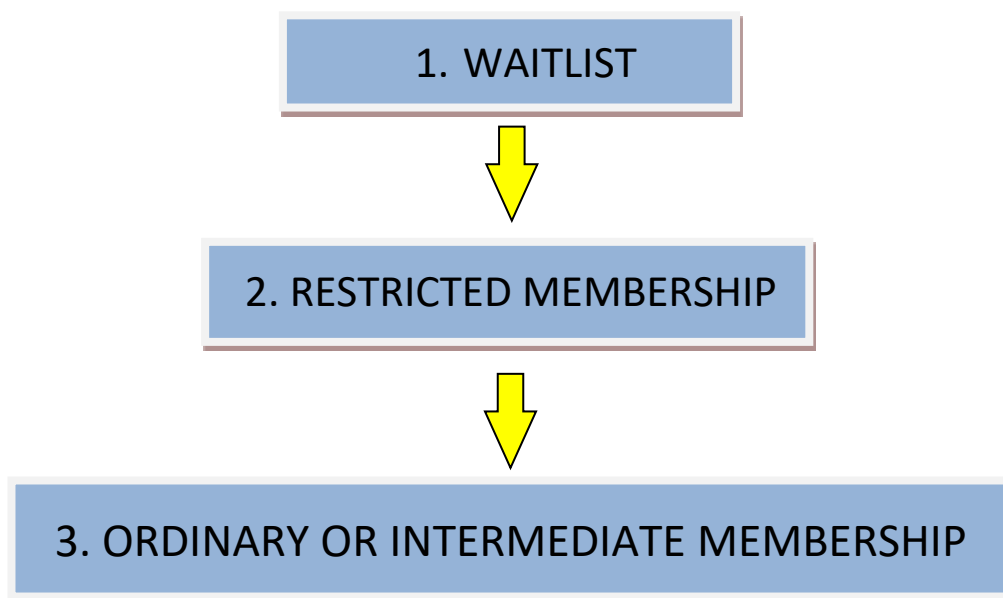

Part 2 – Current Membership Joining Process

Golf membership for 18+ years of age is full and our waitlist is currently closed. Our current wait time is approximately 36 months. Please check our website for updates.



1. When the membership waitlist reopens, you can place your name on the list. When on the waitlist you will be emailed your waitlist number, estimated time of wait and a link to an online form. Once the online form is completed you will be required to pay a \$500.00 non-refundable deposit towards your Entrance Fee.
2. **When Offered Restricted Membership*:**
 - When your name reaches to the top of the membership waitlist you will be emailed a “Golf Membership Offer”
 - Attached to the email will be a Restricted Membership Nomination Form for completion and return
 - Once the completed form has been received we send a “Membership Welcome” email. This email provides important information including your membership portal login and password. Once this email has been received you are ready to book and play golf as a Restricted Member
 - An invoice will also be attached to the Membership Welcome email. The invoice will include: Entrance Fee, Subscription Fee and Affiliation Fee. Payment details and payment options will be included in the email. For more information on membership fees, please refer to part 3 of this document
 - Completed Nomination Form are tabled for approval at the next Management Committee Meeting

*When offered golf membership, you will enter via **Restricted Membership**. Restricted Membership is a pathway to **Ordinary Membership (or Intermediate Membership if under the age of 30)**. Restricted Membership has the following limitations:

- Cannot to book Saturday competitions golf until the day before the competition
- No voting rights
- Cannot run for a Management Committee position

Restricted Members are upgraded to Ordinary Membership or Intermediate Membership when a position becomes available. This upgrade is based on Restricted Membership join date seniority. The club currently has a cap of 1000 Ordinary Membership positions, included in these 1000 positions are Ordinary Members and Intermediate Members.

Direct Debit Agreements may be available on request to pay the Annual Subscription Fee and Affiliation Fee component when joining (providing you join between 1st October to 31st May of any membership year)

** Junior membership fee of \$115.50 is a flat rate regardless of the joining date with the renewal date of 30 September

NB: Restricted Membership fees are the same as Ordinary and Intermediate membership Fees. Restricted Membership is a pathway to Ordinary and Intermediate Membership and is offered only when Ordinary and Intermediate Memberships are at Capacity.

PLEASE NOTE: The membership year runs from 1st October to 30th September. Subscription are calculated on a monthly pro-rata basis depending on the month of joining.

Part 4 – Golf Bookings (Competition and Social Play)

Competition Golf:

Headland Golf Club has a number of regular weekly competitions. Bookings for competitions are made via our online timesheets, which open 7 days prior at 6.30pm (except for Veteran's competitions).

Monday Individual Veteran Competition (approximately 1 to 2 rounds per month)

Approximate Tee Times from 7:00am to 9:00am, or a Shotgun Start (normally at 8.00am)
Members must join the Headland Veterans Association at a nominal fee to play

Tuesday Individual/ Medley Competition

Approximate Tee Times from 8:30am to 12:30pm

Wednesday Individual/ Medley Competition

Approximate Morning Tee Times from 6:36am to 8:20am
Approximate Afternoon Tee Times from 10:47am to 12:47pm

Thursday Women's 18 Hole Competition

Approximate Tee Times from 7:00am to 9.00am

Thursday Men's Competition

Approximate Tee Times from 11:19am to 12:47pm

Saturday Individual/ Medley Competition

Approximate Morning Tee Times from 6:12am to 8:12am
Approximate Afternoon Tee Times from 10:47am to 12:47pm

Saturday Junior Competition

Approximate Tee Times from 3:07pm to 4:03pm

Sunday Individual/ Medley Competition

Approximate Tee Times from 10.00am to 12.00noon

Social Golf:

Social Golf timesheets open for booking two weeks before the event at 6.30pm for Monday and Friday timesheets and 5.30pm for all other days.

Outside of competition times, the course is available for social play. All social golf must be booked through the Member's Portal/App or by calling the Pro Shop. The best days for 18 holes social golf are Monday, Friday and Sunday, while 9 holes social golf is generally available every day.
